Entry Guidelines

National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum Prix de West Invitational Art Exhibition and Sale

The Prix de West® Invitational Art Exhibition and Sale is in keeping with the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum's long standing commitment to the exhibition of outstanding contemporary Western art. The goal of the Museum is to bring together painting and sculpture of the highest quality found today.

Artist's work being submitted to the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum Screening Committee must meet the following criteria:

- Up to a maximum of 10 digital images representing the best examples of your work.
- Professional quality digital image with no background distractions.
- JPG format at a maximum resolution of 150 dpi, and maximum width or height of 16 inches saved to a CD.
- Name each file with the title of work. Do not include the artist's name or any other information in the JPG filename.
- Include on the CD, in separate PDF files,
 - Title, dimensions and medium of each piece of work submitted
 - Artist's Biography
 - List of awards, and any other pertinent information

There is a screening fee of \$50 payable by check or money order. Include your name, address, phone number and e-mail address.

Entries must be sent to the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum between January 1 and April 15 to be considered for the following year's show.

Selections will be made by the Prix de West Screening Committee in late June and applicants will be notified of their selection.

If you wish to have your entry information returned after the screening, include an addressed, stamped return envelope with your submission.
